Jacob was ready. He had pins with him, a purple one for CRMO and a colorful one for autism, and he made sure every single player got one. He didn't hang back. He walked right up.



RAY'S REMINDER

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM **UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED DRIVERS**

Texas has one of the highest rates of uninsured drivers in the country. That means every time you get behind the wheel, there is a real chance that if someone hits you, they cannot cover your medical bills, lost wages, or any of the damage they caused.

What makes it worse is that drivers who do have insurance often carry the Texas state minimum, which is \$30,000 per person. If you are seriously injured, that number can run out fast.

This is where Uninsured and Underinsured Motorist coverage, known as UM/UIM, becomes one of the most important things you can add to your policy. It steps in when the other driver cannot pay, and it covers you in ways that their insurance simply cannot. It is typically one of the least expensive coverages you can add, and one of the most valuable.

If you are not sure whether you have it, pull up your policy declarations page, and take a look. If you do not have it, call your insurance agent as soon as possible.

Bottom line: *You cannot control who hits you, but you can control whether you are protected when they do.*
