When Scott Snellings launched The Driven Crowd, the idea was simple: sit down with driven people, hear their stories, and share what makes them tick. One hundred episodes later, the show has grown into something none of us could have fully predicted, and Episode 100 deserved a moment that matched the milestone.

So, we went to the Grand Canyon. There is something about standing at the edge of one of the most breathtaking places on earth that puts things in perspective. It was the perfect backdrop for a conversation about the journey, what it has meant, and where it is going next. Some episodes you record in a studio. This one felt like it needed a little more sky.

Charley Mann made the trip as well, and for good reason. Charley holds a distinction nobody else in the history of the show has earned: he is the first three-time guest on The Driven Crowd. That alone tells you something about the kind of conversations he brings to the table every time he sits down with Scott.

But the real story of Episode 100 is what happened behind the mic. For the first time in the history of the show, Scott was not the one asking the questions. He was the one answering them.

After nearly a hundred episodes of drawing out the stories of entrepreneurs, athletes, lawyers, and leaders, Scott finally sat in the other chair. What came out of that conversation was honest, personal, and long overdue. The lessons he has learned, the moments that shaped him, and what it actually means to build something you believe in, all of it on the record for the first time.

One hundred episodes is not just a number. It is a hundred conversations, a hundred stories, and a hundred reminders of why showing up consistently matters. Thank you to everyone who has tuned in, shared an episode, or told a friend. This one was for you.

RAY'S REMINDER

AFTER AN ACCIDENT, DOCUMENT EVERYTHING. **EVEN IF YOU FEEL FINE!**

After an accident, it is natural to focus on getting home, calming down, and moving on. But what you do in the hours and days that follow can have a real impact on your case down the road.

Here is what you should do right away:

- Take photos at the scene of the vehicles, any visible injuries, road conditions, and anything else that tells the story of what happened.
- Write down what you remember as soon as possible. Details fade fast and your account of events matters.
- See a doctor even if you feel okay. Injuries like whiplash and concussions do not always show up immediately, and gaps in medical care can be used against your claim.
- Save everything: medical bills, repair estimates, and any communication from the insurance company.

Why It Matters

The strength of your case often comes down to what was documented early. Evidence disappears, memories fade, and insurance companies move quickly. A little preparation today can make a significant difference later.
